WHEN THE VEHICLE BEING TITLED IS EXEMPT FROM ODOMETER DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS. **EXEMPTIONS:** A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A MODEL YEAR OF 2011 OR NEWER IS EXEMPT AFTER TWENTY (20) YEARS AND A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A MODEL YEAR OF 2010 OR OLDER IS EXEMPT AFTER TEN (10) YEARS, HAS A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING (GVWR) OF MORE THAN 16,000 POUNDS OR IS NOT SELF-PROPELLED.

WHEN SHOULD THIS FORM BE USED?

1. When an insurance company has paid a "Total Loss" on a motor vehicle or mobile home or paid a total theft loss, it must make application for a Salvage Certificate of Title or Certificate of Destruction in the name of the insurance company. Or, if an owner retains possession of a motor vehicle or mobile home after a total loss settlement is paid, the owner may make application for a Salvage Certificate of Title or Certificate of Destruction and will be issued in the name of the owner. (See Sections 5 & 6 of this form).
2. When a motor vehicle or mobile home has been wrecked or damaged and the owner or self-insured determines the estimated costs of repairing the damage is equal to 90 percent or more (or at least 80%) of the current retail value (See Sections 5 & 6 of this form).

NOTE: If requested, a Salvage Rebuildable or Salvage Rebuildable Flood Certificate of Title for an uninsured or self-insured motor vehicle or mobile home may be issued even if the cost of repairing or rebuilding the vehicle is less than 80 percent (To request, see sections 5.f, & 6.c.3 on this form).

3. When applying for a duplicate Certificate of Destruction (See Section 12 of this form).

FILING:

1. ALL APPLICABLE SECTIONS OF THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED LEGIBLY.
2. THIS FORM MUST BE DOCUMENTED BY THE ATTACHMENT OF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING, UNLESS APPLYING FOR A DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF DESTRUCTION:
 - (A) FLORIDA CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR FORM MOTOR VEHICLE TITLE REASSIGNMENT SUPPLEMENT HSMV 82994, NOT APPLICABLE IF TITLE IS ELECTRONIC AND OWNER RETAINED;
 - (B) MANUFACTURER'S CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN;
 - (C) OUT-OF-STATE TITLE OR OTHER OFFICAL PROOF OF OWNERSHIP.

NOTE: A certificate of title will not be issued on a used motor vehicle that has been stolen from an out-of-state owner until the motor vehicle has been recovered and the required VIN verification can be performed.
